2021 CHARDONNAY - 92 POINTS

"A nice interplay between subtle oak spices and generous, ripe fruit flavors gives this full-bodied wine a rich but not overpowering expression. Nuances of toast, butter, poached pears and peach syrup lend an extra confectionary flair to the palate and lingering finish."




2022 PINOT NOIR • 92 POINTS [Editor's Choice]

"Generous floral and black-fruit aromas are echoed in pure, focused black cherries, cloves and cinnamon flavors, while moderate tannins are well integrated for a soft texture. It's a charming and flavorful wine that's easy to love. Editors' Choice."



2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON • 92 POINTS

"This taut and well-balanced wine offers focused aromas and flavors of black cherries, raspberries, cinnamon and toast on a firm texture of good acidity and muscular tannins. While tempting now for its layers of fruit and oak spice, the wine should show best from 2026."



2022 ZINFANDEL • 92 POINTS (Editor's Choice)

"This sleek, elegant wine holds a surprising amount of concentrated blackberries, raspberries and strawberries on a silky texture soothed by light tannins. Layers of fruit keep revealing more black fruits, mint and black pepper notes."
