# Fiesta 2013 89 points

"Fresh raspberry, floral and white pepper aromas show good clarity and lift. Sappy, seamless red berry flavors are complemented by a hint of candied licorice, putting on weight with air. Finishes silky and seamless, with good length and a suggestion of candied flowers. Great value here."



#### Abril 2013 89 points

"High-pitched red berry and floral scents show good clarity and a hint of fresh tobacco. Lively and focused on the palate, offering bitter cherry and redcurrant flavors that flesh out with air. Tightens up on the finish, which features building tannins and a lingering note of bitter chocolate."



# Seis 2012 91 points

"Ripe cherry and coconut on the perfumed nose, with a smoky nuance adding complexity. Smooth, sweet and seamless on the palate, offering fleshy, deeply pitched dark fruit and spicecake flavors that become spicier with air. Supple tannins come on late, adding shape to the long, smoke-tinged finish, which echoes the cherry note."



### Garciano 2012 *90 points*

"Raspberry, floral pastilles and peppery spices on the perfumed nose and palate. Sappy and focused, displaying very good intensity and a silky, seamless texture. Finishes sweet, nervy and long, with sneaky tannins and an echo of fresh red berries."

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
