CHIROUBLES 2017 || 92 points

"Bright violet color. Vibrant, sharply focused red berry, cherry and floral pastille scents, along with suggestions of musky earth and licorice. In an elegant, seamless style, offering juicy raspberry and bitter cherry flavors that turn sweeter as the wine opens up. The floral note comes back on a very long, lively finish that's framed by silky tannins that fold smoothly into the sappy fruit.."



FLEURIE 2018 || 93 points

"Youthful purple. Highly perfumed boysenberry, cherry and lavender scents show outstanding clarity and pick up a smoky mineral nuance with aeration. Sappy and sharply focused in the mouth, offering concentrated, mineral-drenched red fruit, floral pastille and spicecake flavors that deftly blend power and delicacy. Finishes with sharp focus and silky, even tannins that add gentle grip to the impressively long, floral-dominated finish."



MORGON 2017 || 92 points

"Brilliant ruby. Powerful, spice-accented red/blue fruit scents are complemented by hints of candied violet and incense. Broad and appealingly sweet, offering palate-staining boysenberry and cherry liqueur flavors that are given lift and focus by a spine of smoky minerality. In an ample but lively style, showing solid finishing thrust, molten tannins and lingering sweetness."



RÉGNIÉ 2017 || 91 points

"Deep, shimmering red. Intensely perfumed aromas of fresh red berries, potpourri and smoky minerals. Sweet and seamless on the palate, offering juicy red/dark berry flavors along with candied rose and spicecake flourishes. Shows very good clarity, spicy punch and resonating red fruit character on a long, incisive finish that's framed by silky, harmonious tannins."
