BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Mestizaje Blanco 2012 {Vino de Espana}



90 points

"Spicy citrus, mineral and floral scents are deepened by notes of pear skin and anise. Tangy and focused, with finely etched Meyer lemon, green apple and fennel flavors. Gains depth with air and finishes with chalky mineral cut and lingering citrus fruit qualities."



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Mestizaje Tinto 2011 {Vino de Espana}

89 points

"Highly perfumed scents of smoky dark fruits, violet, resiny herbs and cracked pepper. Fleshy and sweet, with deep blackcurrant and bitter cherry flavors lifted by brisk acidity and nicely framed by supple tannins. Gains spiciness on the long, sweet finish, which leaves a smoky note behind."



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Finca Terrerazo 2010 {DOP El Terrerazo} 91 points

"Sexy, floral black and blue fruits on the nose, with a spicy nuance adding lift. Plush and broad on entry, then tighter in the the mid-palate, offering lively boysenberry and bitter cherry flavors and a hint of sweet vanillin oak. Supple tannins shape the finish, which lingers with impressive tenacity."



BODEGAS MUSTIGUILLO Quincha Corral 2011 {DOP El Terrerazo}

92 points

"A heady, complex bouquet evokes candied dark berries, cola, incense and smoky minerals. Sweet, palate-staining blackberry and violet pastille flavors are braced by juicy acidity and show excellent clarity. Closes spicy and very long, with supple tannins coming on late."

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
