LZ 2019 || 94 points

“Very pretty and aromatic with plum and orange peel with floral undertones. Medium to full body, with very fine tannins and a beautiful, fine-grained finish. Drinkable now, but a year or two will real show it off. From organically grown grapes. Drink after 2022.”



CORRIENTE 2018 || 94 points

“A dense, very polished red with beautiful tannins and complex flavors of dark berries, plums and walnuts with some fresh herbs and spices that come through subtly at the finish. Full and creamy. Drink after 2022.”



LANZAGA 2015 || 95 points

“A rich, layered red with cherry, chocolate and coffee character. Hints of iodine and oyster shell. Medium-bodied and well integrated with fine tannins and a savory finish. Drink now or hold.”



LANZAGA 2016 || 94 points

“Sweet berries, cherries and flowers with lemon-rind character. Full-bodied, yet tight and very polished with creamy tannins and a beautiful finish. Delicious with lots of fruit. Drink now.”



TABURNIGA 2017 || 97 points

“Love the aromas of lavender and rosemary with dark berries and brambleberries. Full-bodied with round, creamy tannins that are well integrated with the fruit, if a little young still. From organically grown grapes. Give this wine two or three years to melt together. Better after 2022.”



LA ESTRADA 2017 || 96 points

“A dense, layered red with blue fruit, lavender and some violets. It’s full and rich, yet tight and chewy. Really needs time to soften some of the rather angular tannins. But showing lots of terroir-driven character. From organically grown grapes. Better after 2022.”



EL VELADO 2017 || 96 points

“A very fruity red with a tight, fine-tannin frame that gives the wine form and purpose. It’s full-bodied and very linear. Racy finish. From organically grown grapes. This will age beautifully. Try after 2022.”



LAS BEATAS 2017 || 97 points

“Aromas of fresh flowers and subtle red fruit follow through to a full body with very tight tannins that are polished and refined. Extremely long and linear on the palate, the wine carries you along swiftly as you taste it. Give it time to open. Try after 2022 and onwards.”
