BODEGAS RODA



Sela 2014 || 90 points

"This wine moves into the cassis and blue plum zone, with baking spices and a slightly tarry edge. The palate falls ripe and a little dry, but overall it is attractive and delicious. Drink now."

Roda Reserva 2012 || 95 points

"Very fresh, deep black fruit and licorice character. Rich and complex, but also very lively for its age. The refined tannins are beautifully integrated and drive the long, complex finish. Delicious now."
