“Journey to Priorat” – Viatge al Priorat is from the younger vines of the estate, located along the impossibly steep southern slopes of the DO. The soils are all llicorella (black slate) at an altitude ranging from 400-

600 meters. A great introduction to this extreme region, or for those looking for a more youthful expression (read: not-so-brooding). While the fruit is deep and dark, minerality from the slates, lively acidity and delicate tannin give the wine a taut structure and lift.
